The indoor range is a 50 foot, 12 firing point range. The indoor range is only open for designated matches and practice dates.

The Chillicothe Sportsmen's Club archery range is located on 30 naturally wooded acres, offering 40 3D targets. The practice area has targets with a range from 10 to 60 yards. There is an average of 8 3D competitions per year. Broadheads are not to be used on any of the club targets. If you want to shoot broadheads for practice, bring your own broadhead target. Crossbows are allowed.

The Chillicothe Sportsmen's Club regularly hosts these activities: NRA High Power Rifle Matches, Military Rifle Matches, Small Bore Rifle Indoor League, Sporting Rifle Outdoor League, Traditional Muzzle Loader Matches, Steel Buffalo Shoots, Open Trap and Trap Leagues, Indoor / Outdoor Bullseye pistol, USPSA Action Pistol, Three Gun / Steel Matches, Bowling Pin Matches, SASS / Cowboy Action Shoots, Women's Target Shooting, Youth / Scouting Activities, 3D Archery Shoots, Hunter Education Classes

The Chillicothe Sportsmen's Club has a small, 2 acre, lake that is stocked with bass, crappie, and catfish. Minnows are not allowed.

Light Camping (tent camping only) is allowed at the club.

There is a covered pavilion by the lake that is available on a first come, first served basis.

The Chillicothe Sportsmen's Club features a club house that is complete with an indoor range in the lower level, full kitchen facilities, and a 40 X 60 foot dining area.

We do not provide regular food service.

The club house is available to rent for reunions, weddings, dances, etc. The Club Facilities include tables, chairs, and a PA system.
