Annual Meeting:

Please plan to attend our annual meeting and election of officers on Tuesday November 11. The meeting will be held at 6:30PM in the clubhouse. This is an opportunity for you to influence the future of our club and get to know your new officers.

From Our Treasurer:

The end of the membership year is approaching. The club does not send out

bills or invoices. The newsletter is the only reminder you get until you find that your key no longer opens the gate after January 1.

If there has been any change in your name or address, please notify the club now. By November 1, the mailing labels and new membership cards are printed. If you have not notified the club of a change in your address by then, your new card and key will be sent to your old address. When information updates arrive in the club mail, in order to process it as quickly as possible, the new info is not compared to the pre-printed label, but simply mailed out on the pre-printed label.

Due to the membership going over 1000, the board has made some policy changes that will affect some people. If you are going south this winter, be sure and take care of renewing your membership before you leave.

Unlike in the past, the board is not accepting new members for 2015 until the February Board Meeting, in order to give current members the opportunity to renew before we give their spot to someone else. There are names on the waiting list to join the club.

If a current member has not renewed by the February Board Meeting, their spot may be given to a new member. The person wanting to rejoin will have to take their chance on there being an opening, reapply for membership, pay the application fee, and go through the New Member Orientation just like any other new member, and they will still owe their work hours for 2014. It will be cheaper and easier to renew ahead of time.

There will be opportunity to renew memberships at the Annual Meeting and Election of Officers November 11, and at the December Gun Show.

Anyone who joins now will need to renew by January 1, when the lock is changed.

Also, the board made a change in the club rules at the July meeting:

1) F. No class 3 firearms allowed unless authorized by the Board. Each use/event must be approved by the Board. Use of near full-auto devices (example: 'slidefire', 'bumpfire', 'slamfire', Tapcon trigger, et.al.) is not allowed due to safety issues.

Proposed Club By-Laws Changes:

CURRENT BY-LAW SECTIONS

ARTICLE 4: MEMBERSHIP

Section 5: Annual Members: Annual Members shall be those persons submitting a written application form and being elected to membership by the Board of Directors. Such memberships shall automatically terminate, without further action, if the required dues are not paid by January 1st of each year. Any Annual Member accepted to membership on or after January 1st in each year shall be considered a member for the year in which elected. All former members will be accountable for any delinquent fees owed from their previous membership as of January 1, 2003. This must be paid before being accepted as a new current member. (11-12-2002)

Section 9: <u>Dues and Fees</u>: Dues and Fees of Annual and Junior Members shall not exceed a \$100 initiation fee and \$100 per year annual dues. Associate Life Membership fees shall not exceed the one-time sum of ten times the current annual amount charged Annual Members. The Board of directors shall set exact amount of these dues and fees for the coming year. A \$10 per month late fee, retroactive to January 1st, (for up to 3 months) will be assessed for ALL Members – Annual, Associate Life and Life Members failing to pay their fees on time. <u>All Members, without any late fee penalty, will be allowed to February 1, to pay their dues and fees</u>. (11-11-2008) (11/10/09)

Section 10: Work Requirements: All Members except Honorary Members, Junior members and Life Members over the age of 65 must work a minimum of ten (10) hours per year on a project

approved by the Board of Directors with the actual hours worked verified by a Board Member. Any member who fails to complete their work requirements shall pay a sum, not to exceed \$10.00, for each hour not worked, as the Board of Directors shall set each year. The work hours to be performed for each year shall be performed in the calendar year in question and shall not carry over. (11-14-2000)

PROPOSED 2014 AMENDMENTS

ARTICLE 4: MEMBERSHIP

Section 5: <u>Annual Members</u>: Annual Members shall be those persons submitting a written application form and being <u>approved for</u> membership by the Board of Directors. Such memberships shall automatically terminate, without further action, if the required dues are not paid by February 1st of each year. Any Annual Member accepted to membership on or after January 1st in each year shall be considered a member for the year in which selected. All former members will be accountable for any delinquent fees owed from their previous membership. This must be paid before being accepted as a new current member. (11-11-2014)

Section 9: <u>Dues and Fees</u>: Dues and Fees of Annual and Junior Members shall not exceed a \$100 non-refundable application fee and \$200 per year annual dues. Associate Life Membership fees shall not exceed the one-time sum of ten times the current annual amount charged Annual Members. The Board of directors shall set exact amount of these dues and fees for the coming year. Any annual member not renewing by February 1st will lose their membership status and will have to re-apply as a new member. (11/11/2014)

Section 10: Work Requirements: All Members except Honorary Members, Junior members, and Life Members over the age of 65 must work a minimum of ten (10) hours per year on a project approved by the Board of Directors with the actual hours worked verified by a Board Member or Program Director. Any member who fails to complete their work requirements shall pay a sum, not to exceed \$20, for each hour not worked, as the Board of Directors shall set each year. The work hours to be performed for each year shall be performed in the calendar year in question and shall not carry over. (11-11-2014)


