As my wife and I travel outside the USA, I make it a point to inquire about the firearms laws. Having just returned from Costa Rica, here is their situation. You can own a firearm, but it is very restrictive. You must be photographed and fingerprinted. All firearms are registered to you by serial number. If one is stolen or used in a crime, they will come and get you. For

every firearm you own, you must go to the police and qualify once per year by demonstrating a score. Oh yes, hunting is strictly prohibited in Costa Rica.

Here are some other countries where firearm ownership is strictly banned: Croatia, Bosnia, Slovenia, Montenegro, Peru, Ecuador. In my opinion the last thing these dictator types want is an armed population.

I think we are headed in the same direction.

Just remember: The price of freedom is eternal vigilance.

What do I need to start shooting high power rifle competition at CSC? High Power Rifle Matches

What do I need to start shooting high power rifle competition at CSC?Hearing and Eye protection along with money for ammo and match fees. THAT's IT!!!

- This runs \$36 to \$41 for a 60 round draw of 223 with the match fee.
- CSC has National Match AR-15's and Service Grade M1 Garands available for borrowing at the match
- 223, 30-06, and 308 available for very competitive prices at the matches.

When are the matches and what do the other competitors bring for equipment?

- The matches are usually held on the 3rd Saturday of the month with the first relay starting at 8:30 AM March through October. First Match in 2015 is March 21 at 1:00. Watch the CSC Calendar.



This guy is from Costa Rica. I wish we had some of these on the club grounds. They are very friendly.


