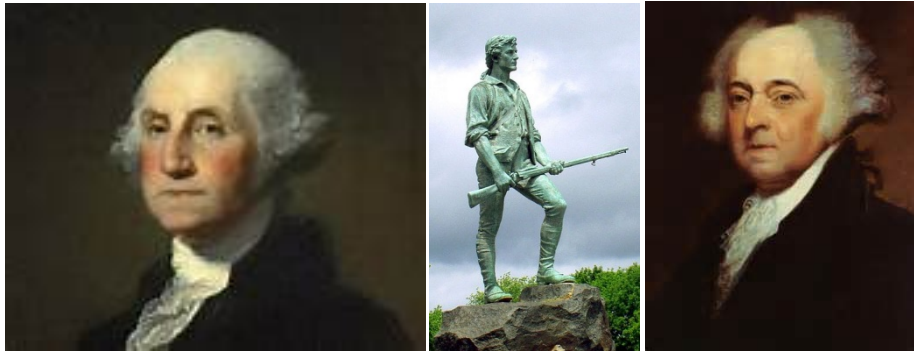

And Finally:

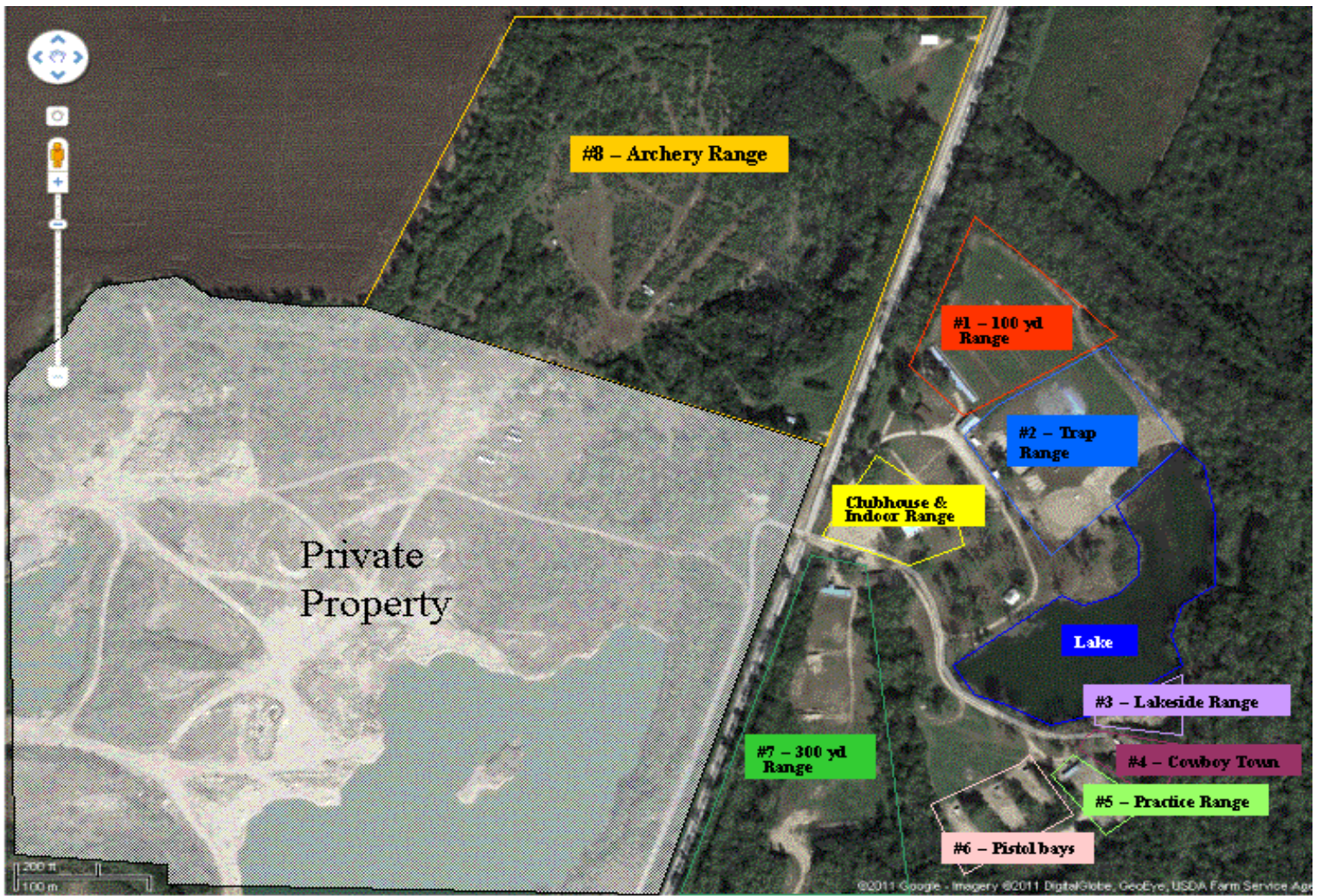
