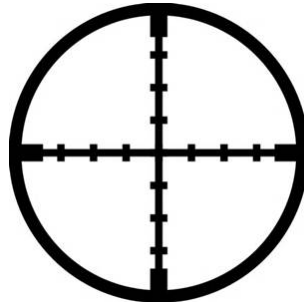


# Chillicothe Sportsmen's Club

**We have received a lot of questions about membership renewal. Here is an example per our webmaster Tim Vik:**

Work hours:  $10 - 4 = 6$

Work hr fees:  $6 \times \$10 = \$60$

Annual Member dues = \$100

Land Fee =                      \$10

**Total =                      \$170 (Annual Member only - if you are a Life or Associate life, it would be \$60+\$10)**

**Note that the minimum amount any annual member would owe is \$110 (all hours worked) and the maximum would be \$210 (no hours worked). Note for our Associate Life and Life Members - your dues are simply based on the hours you worked and the land fee so anywhere between \$10 and \$110. Once the total**

amount is determined, send your 2015 membership card and the total amount due to: Chillicothe Sportsmen's Club P.O. Box13 Chillicothe, IL 61523

We do not send out bills or notices. It is up to you to get it done. The locks were changed on January 1. Send in your card with your work hours and fees and you will get a new key and card. After January 1, you can leave your old key in the clubhouse mailbox to be recycled.

**Per our membership director Bob Griffith:**

As of the January board meeting 748 of our members have renewed for 2016, 249 have not. If you do not renew by February, we will process the 60 plus membership applications we have in the queue, and you will have to start over as a new member. Get busy.

## **Well Armed Women Program:**

The Greater Peoria Area Chapter of the Well-Armed Woman meets on the 4th Friday of each month. Membership is open to any woman over age 21 who is legally able to own a firearm. We are women teaching women.

Meetings are from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm at the main clubhouse. You can attend one meeting before deciding to join. Each meeting usually consists of a one hour program on a gun related topic and one hour of range time. You must be a member to shoot. You are welcome to watch. We usually have eye and ear protection for you to wear.

We help new shooters to learn the basics and try to get them involved with shooting sports of some sort. We do provide firearms for first time shooters. There is a \$5.00 range fee plus the cost of ammunition. You will need to take a gun safety course if you are a new shooter. It's pretty fun. We stress safety at all times. We have NRA certified instructors and RSO's.

This month it will be on the 22nd of Jan. Our topic is Holster Clinic. We will have a wide variety of holsters for you to look at and try on. You can learn from others mistakes what works and what doesn't. Each person's needs are different and we have almost every holster that is available, and then some.

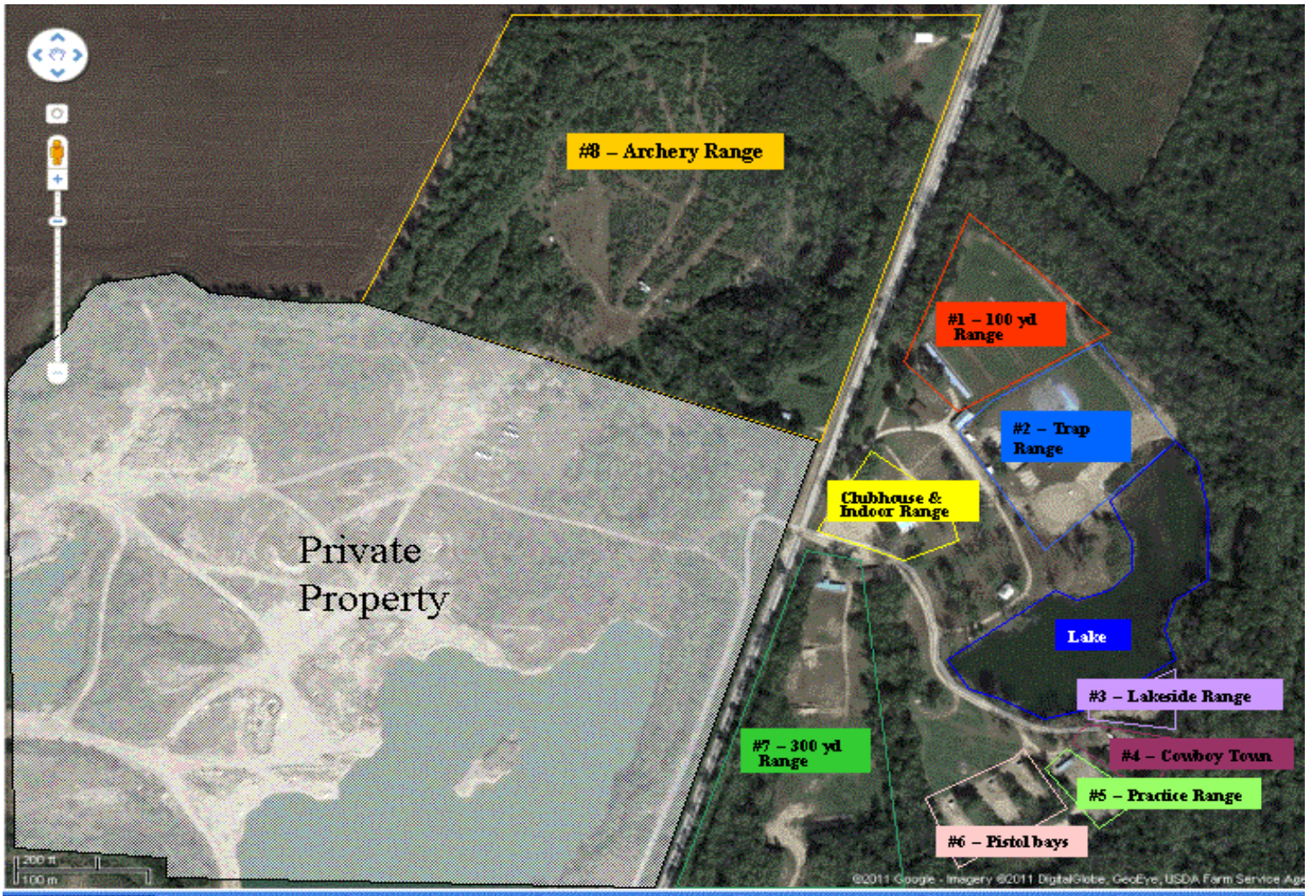
