

Introduction to Bulls-eye Pistol Shooting

Class starts Wednesday March 2 @ 6:00 PM Chillicothe Sportsman Club

The class runs for 4 weeks, every Wednesday night

Class covers

- Safety
- Operation of pistols
- Techniques for sighting
- Breathing
- Trigger control
- Rules of Bulls-eye shooting

No experience is necessary; we provide Ruger Mark III 22/45 pistols to use ammo and targets or you can bring your own pistol (no Magnum rounds, i.e. 357mag, 44mag). 22lr, 380acp, 9mm, 38spl, 40S&W, 45 ACP, etc. are OK

Cost is \$75.00 this covers Ammo (350 rounds) and targets

Cost is \$35.00 if you are supplying your own gun and ammo

The Chillicothe Sportsman club is located about 1.5 miles north of Chillicothe on route 29. There is a sign on the right side of the road when heading north.


