

The Chillicothe Sportsmen's Club has a small, eight acre lake that is stocked with bass, crappie, and catfish. Boats with motors other than trolling are not allowed. Minnows are not allowed.



Club membership includes the immediate family. Members receive a monthly newsletter and activity calendar. The club newsletter and calendar are also available online at the club website.



The Chillicothe Sportsmen's Club features a club house that is complete with an indoor range in the lower level, full kitchen facilities, and a 40 X 60 foot dining area.

The Club Facilities include tables, chairs, and a PA system.

The club house is available to rent for weddings and dances.

The indoor range is a 50 foot, 12 firing point range with turning targets. The range is open for designated matches and practice dates.



The Chillicothe Sportsmen's Club archery range is located on 3.3 naturally wooded acres, offering 40 3D targets. The practice area has targets with a range from 10 to 60 yards. There is an average of 8 3D competitions open to both members and the general public. Limited instruction is available.

Crossbows, Broadheads, or Alcohol are **NOT** permitted on the range.

The Chillicothe Sportsmen's Club is located one mile north of Chillicothe, Illinois just off of Illinois Route 29 on Yankee Lane.

The Chillicothe Sportsmen's Club is a not-for-profit Illinois Corporation that is affiliated with Ducks Unlimited (DU), the National Rifle Association (NRA), the Illinois State Rifle Association (ISRA), Illinois Department of Natural Resources (IDNR), the Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) and ATA sanctioned Trap Shoots.



The Chillicothe Sportsmen's Club has a 25, 50, 100, 200 and 300 yard rifle range as well as 4 pistol bays. All have covered shooting areas with benches / tables.

There is a lighted three-house trap range with voice activated throwing systems.

All new members are required to attend a 2-hour Club safety orientation session prior to the issuance of their membership card and key.
